Work consists rehabilitating approximately 11,000 linear feet of 6-inch and 8-inch water mains, and other such work as may be necessary to complete the contract, in accordance with the drawings, technical specifications, special provisions, and City of Columbus Construction and Material Specifications as set forth in the Invitation For Bid (IFB).

The Community Planning Areas are “40 – North Linden”. The primary streets include Homecroft Dr., Oaklawn St., Homestead Dr., Kenlawn St., Northridge Rd., Lenore Ave., Caroyne Ave., and Pauline Ave.

6. **A narrative timeline for the contract including a beginning date, beginning and ending dates for known phases of the contract and a projected ending date.**

All work shall be complete within 270 calendar days from the Notice to Proceed. The City anticipates issuing a Notice to Proceed in March 2022.

7. **A narrative discussing the economic impact or economic advantages of the project; community outreach or input in the development of the project; and any environmental factors or advantages of the project.**

The goal of this project is to replace or rehabilitate the existing water lines that have a high break frequency. Replacement of these water lines will improve water service, decrease burden on water maintenance operations, and reduce water loss. The Neighborhood Liaison(s) has been contacted and informed of this project during the design phase. Further community outreach may result through the Neighborhood Liaison Program.

8. **An estimate of the full cost of the Contract including a separate estimate of any and all phases or proposed future contract modifications.**

The bid amount and proposed award amount is \$3,734,444.84, including a 10% construction contingency amount that will be utilized to fund needed and approved changes in the work. No contract modifications are anticipated at this time; however, construction exigency might later compel modification of this contract, if unforeseen difficulties are encountered.
