DOSD determined that other chemicals are not acceptable for use in this program due to either ineffectiveness or the presence of metam sodium, which the US EPA classifies as a likely carcinogen.		
3. Describe efforts to determine/verify that the company is the sole source: Determined by various DOSD personnel and through communication with the vendor. RAZOROOTER®, which contains the active ingredient, diquat dibromide ("diquat"), is a proprietary product of Duke's Root Control, Inc. and is currently the only diquat-based, sewer root control product registered with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Duke's Root Control is the only commercial applicator licensed with Ohio Department of Agriculture to apply this product to sewers.
