Section 3 – CONTRACTOR

<u>Description:</u> A contract is for purpose of obtaining goods and services for the city's own use and creates a procurement relationship with the outside entity. Characteristics indicative of a procurement relationship between the city and an outside entity are when the outside entity:

Provides the goods and services within normal business operations;
Provides similar goods or services to many different purchasers;
Normally operates in a competitive environment;
Provides goods or services that are ancillary to the operation of the Federal prog

Entities that include these characteristics <u>are not</u> subject to compliance requirements of the Federal program as a result of the agreement, though similar requirements may apply for other reasons.
