[Surveyor's description of the premises follows]

Situated in the State of Ohio, City of Columbus, Franklin County, Quarter Township No. 3, Township 2N, Range 17W, U.S. Military District and being part of a 13.871 acre tract conveyed to Tanager Woods Owners Association in Deed Book 3404, page 665 as platted with Sunbury Heights P.U.D. District 1 in Plat book 46, page 77 in the Franklin County Recorder's Office. The below described parcel laying on the right side of the centerline right of way for Sugarbush Boulevard (60.00 feet wide) and recorded in Plat Book 46, Page 77, and being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at a 5/8" rebar found in good condition at a 20.00 foot radius return on the southerly existing right of way for said Sugarbush Boulevard and the easterly existing right of way for Wrangell Place (50.00 feet wide) and recorded in Plat Book 46, Page 77, said pin being 30.00 feet right of the centerline of said Sugarbush Boulevard at station 8+93.93 and being the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING** for the parcel herein described:

- 1) **Thence**, along the southerly existing right of way for said Sugarbush Boulevard, **South 86 degrees 19 minutes 30 seconds East 251.17 feet** to a 3/4" iron pipe found in good condition at a 20.00 foot radius return for the southerly existing right of way for said Sugarbush Boulevard and the westerly existing right of way for Smoky Place (50.00 feet wide) and recorded in Plat Book 46, Page 77, said pin being 30.00 feet right of the centerline of said Sugarbush Boulevard at station 11+45.09;

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- 2) **Thence**, with the 20.00 foot radius return for the southerly existing right of way for said Sugarbush Boulevard and the westerly existing right of way for said Smoky Place with a curve to the right having a radius of 20.00 feet, a central angle of 56 degrees 56 minutes 17 seconds, an arc length of 19.88 feet and a chord that bears **South 54 degrees 41 minutes 36 seconds East 19.07 feet** to an iron pin set, said pin being 40.00 feet right of the centerline of said Sugarbush Boulevard at station 11+61.33;
- 3) **Thence**, across the said 13.871 acre tract, **North 86 degrees 19 minutes 30 seconds West 284.71 feet** to an iron pin set on 20.00 radius return for the easterly existing right of way for said Wrangell Place and the southerly existing right of way for said Sugarbush Boulevard, said pin being 40.00 feet right of the centerline of said Sugarbush Boulevard at station 8+76.61;
- 4) **Thence**, with the 20.00 radius return for the easterly existing right of way for said Wrangell Place and the southerly existing right of way for said Sugarbush Boulevard with a curve to the right having a radius of 20.00 feet, a central angle of 60 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds, an arc length of 20.94 feet and a chord that bears **North 63 degrees 40 minutes 30 seconds East 20.00 feet** to the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 0.063 acres.

The parcel of land described contains, 0.063 acres, more or less in Franklin County Auditor's Parcel Number 600-162933-00 including the present road occupies 0.000 acres, more or less.

All irons pins set are 5/8 inch x 30 inch rebar with a 1 inch plastic cap stamped "2LMN, Inc".
