ADDENDUM TO THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, OHIO TRAFFIC SAFETY OFFICE AND COLUMBUS PUBLIC HEALTH

This Addendum to the Memorandum of Agreement (the "Agreement" or the "MOA") between the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Ohio Traffic Safety Office ("ODPS/OTSO"), 1970 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43223 and Columbus Public Health ("the Grantee"), 240 Parsons Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43215, jointly "the Parties," is hereby entered into and agreed upon by the Parties. The Parties mutually understand and agree upon the following terms:

- 1. **Background and Purpose.** On April 6, 2023, the Parties entered into an Agreement whereby ODPS/OTSO would pay the Grantee Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) so the Grantee could: a) award driver training scholarships to eligible at-need youth; and b) cover a portion of its grant administration costs. Section IV ("Term of Memorandum of Agreement") of the Agreement states, in relevant part, "The MOA will remain in effect up to and including June 30, 2025, until Grantee expends all of the grant funds, or until terminated by one of the Parties, whichever date is sooner. This MOA may be renewed upon mutual agreement of the Parties."
- 2. **Amendment.** The "June 30, 2025" expiration date in Section IV ("Term of Memorandum of Agreement") of the Agreement is hereby stricken and replaced with a "June 30, 2026" expiration date.
- 3. **Remaining Terms of the Agreement.** All other terms of the Agreement not modified in this Addendum remain unaltered and in full force and effect. This Addendum shall be effective on the date of the Parties' last signature.
