This memorandum is a recommendation for construction contractor selection and processing the construction legislation for the Pedestrian Safety Improvements – Obetz Road Sidewalks - Beth Ann to Parsons project.

<u>Project Scope:</u> Construction of sidewalks and associated handicap ramps on Obetz Road between Beth Ann Drive and Parsons Avenue. Drives will be replaced as needed to meet ADA requirements.

#### Fiscal Impact:

Source of funds is 2011 SIT Certification and New Freedom Grant Funds

Engineer's estimate + inspection (20%): \$284,021.76

Low bid amount + inspection (20%): \$232,858.23

Difference between Engineer's Estimate and bid amount, including inspection: \$51,163.53 less than estimated.

<u>Schedule:</u> Bids were opened June 30, 2011; estimated Council date is September 12, 2011; estimated NTP date is October 10, 2011. The contract length has a completion date of October 31, 2011.

The project will not go to Council until September, after the bond sale occurs for the following reason:

Because of the 2011 bond sale occurring at the end of July, City agencies had to present to the Department of Finance and Management in late June their final list of capital projects that are anticipated to go to council in the month of July and the amount of City funding needed for that project. For this project, DOFM was told that \$100,000 would be needed for this project. OSS and DOMO had further discussions after OSS' meeting with DOFM and OSS learned that the amount of City funds needed was greater than \$100,000.

The delay in going to Council was discussed with DOMO and it is expected that the work would take only a couple of weeks. It is possible that the work could still be completed by the October 31, 2011 completion date. If not, the Department may issue a time extention.
