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After reviewing bid SA001711 for Log Loader Truck, we recommend the award as follows:

Center City International with the Bell Equipment Company alternate bid at \$149,465.00 was the best total bid that meets the specification for the unit. Other total bids received included, FYDA-Freightliner of Columbus at \$145,722.00, Center City International alternate bid with Schodorf Truck Body & Equipment Co. at \$160,920.00, and Center City International alternate bid with Kaffenbarger Truck Equipment Co at \$162,623.00. The apparent low bid by FYDA-Freightliner of Columbus at \$145,722.00 does not meet the specification for the engine displacement size requirement on 3.11.1.

Contract Compliance for Center City International is valid through 09/12/2005.

Recreation and Parks will originate the legislation for this purchase.
