This is a contract for professional engineering design services and services during construction (Design Professional, or "DP" services) for one of the key, time-critical wastewater plants construction projects in the City's Wet Weather Management Plan (WWMP) program, for the period through 2010. The work in that program is a very substantial group of capital improvement projects to the City's two wastewater treatment plants, which have been agreed to by the City and Ohio EPA in order to conform to the requirements of the City's consent orders.

This Contract with CH2M Hill provides engineering services for the Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant Sludge Thickening Improvements and Additional Renovations, Project No. 650359. This contract will implement improvements to the sludge thickening process for both the waste activated and primary sludges, the existing building to be used to house the process, and provide all support systems for this facility, including sludge storage, sludge pumping, polymer feed, wash water, HVAC, odor control, electrical, and Instrumentation and Control in connection with these modifications, and other minor improvements. The actual emplacement of the designed work will be by construction contract; this (DP) contract will provide: preliminary design, detailed design, bidding assistance, construction-phase engineering, start-up and commissioning assistance, record documentatin preparation assistance, and other services for this large project, as directed by the City.

4. <u>An updated contract timeline to contract completion.</u>

As part of the Professional Program Manager's (PPM) scope of services for the capital improvement projects included in the Wet Weather Management Program, 2006 – 2010, the PPM and their team initiated work on the draft Detailed Design Memorandum (DDM) in November, 2006. The DDM was completed and submitted to the City on May 1, 2007. In June, 2007, CH2M Hill proceeded with Detailed Design services.

With the approval of this proposed modification, it is anticipated that CH2M Hill will proceed with the Detailed Design services (Step 2 in September, 2007. It is anticipated that the contract will be bid in January, 2008 and awarded in April, 2008. Construction is anticipated to require approximately two years. CH2M Hill's services will continue beyond completion of construction to provide "as-built" record drawings of the constructed facilities, and a report on the status of operation of the constructed facilities one year after completion.
