The Agilent GC/MS systems currently used in the Drug Identification Section operate with Chemstation software. To be able to read and open data files that were previously acquired on instruments that use Chemstation software, Chemstation software must be included in the new system. There are not any available alternatives.

4. Indicate how the price or fee structure was determined:

The product requirements were emailed to the assigned Agilent sales representative. She prepared a quote for one GC/MS system and all other product items necessary for use in the laboratory. A 15% discount was applied to the GC/MS system and all other items as a result of the Columbus Police Crime Laboratory customer history and repeat business with Agilent.
