The following investigation was conducted concerning the City of Columbus' 2019 annual objection to the renewal of liquor permit **6103115** issued to **MONI & SAMI LLC**, which is doing business as **Convenient Plus** located at **1475 E. Livingston Ave., Columbus, Ohio 43205**. The recorded owner of said permit is **Muhammad Iqbal**.

After reviewing the State of Ohio, Franklin County, and City of Columbus records regarding the above liquor permit establishment, the following information has been compiled to support the objection to the renewal of the aforementioned permit issued by the State of Ohio.

The above listed liquor establishment has been issued a **C1, C2, and D6** permits by the Division of Liquor. This permit grants the permit holder the privilege to sell alcoholic beverages at the above listed address.

An inquiry of liquor violations revealed that the permit holder has received the following violations in **2019**:

SALE AND/OR FURNISHING TO A PERSON UNDER 21

A review of the Columbus Division of Police records revealed the Division of Police has created **(5) five** official police reports concerning incidents at the listed liquor establishment between **January 2018** and **November 2019**. These reports referenced felonious assault, robbery, possession and sale of illegal narcotics, single cigarette sales, and drug overdoses.
