Accela, Inc. provided a letter stating that they are the sole provider of maintenance and support for the EnvisionConnect software application. Additional research verifies that they do not utilize resellers to provide maintenance and support services for their copyrighted software. A direct client relationship is required in order to access and utilize the full capabilities and services.

The vendor provided pricing via quote documents based on the number of system users and modules implemented which was accepted by the City of Columbus.
