The City of Columbus, Transportation Division, has reviewed your request to purchase the excess right-of-way identified as the unimproved 20 foot wide alley east of Ross Avenue from Avalon Place to the unimproved 20 foot wide alley north of Avalon Place. Acquisition of this excess right-of-way will provide you with additional side yard. Columbus City Council Resolution Number 113X-86 provides for the sale of City owned property. After investigation, it was determined the City has no objections to the sale of this right-of-way. Based upon information provided by the Franklin County Auditor the City has estimated a value of \$2,492.00 for this entire alley.

If you wish to proceed with the purchase of this excess right-of-way please sign and date this letter in the space provided below then return, within thirty days, to Ms. Pamela A. Clawson, P.E., Administrator, Transportation Division, Public Service Department, 109 North Front Street, 3rd Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215, Attention: Mary Lu English. If you object to the stated transfer price of \$2,492.00 you will need to contact Ms. Donna Hunter in the Development Department to discuss a possible reduction of this amount. Please provide a copy of any correspondence you send to Ms. Hunter to me for my file.

City will consider when reducing a right-of-way transfer price. Unless mitigating circumstances that directly benefit the Transportation Division can be identified, Division policy requires that a recommendation to transfer at full price be forwarded from the Division to the Development Department.

After an agreement on the transfer price is reached the Development Department will place this request on the Land Review Commission agenda for their consideration.

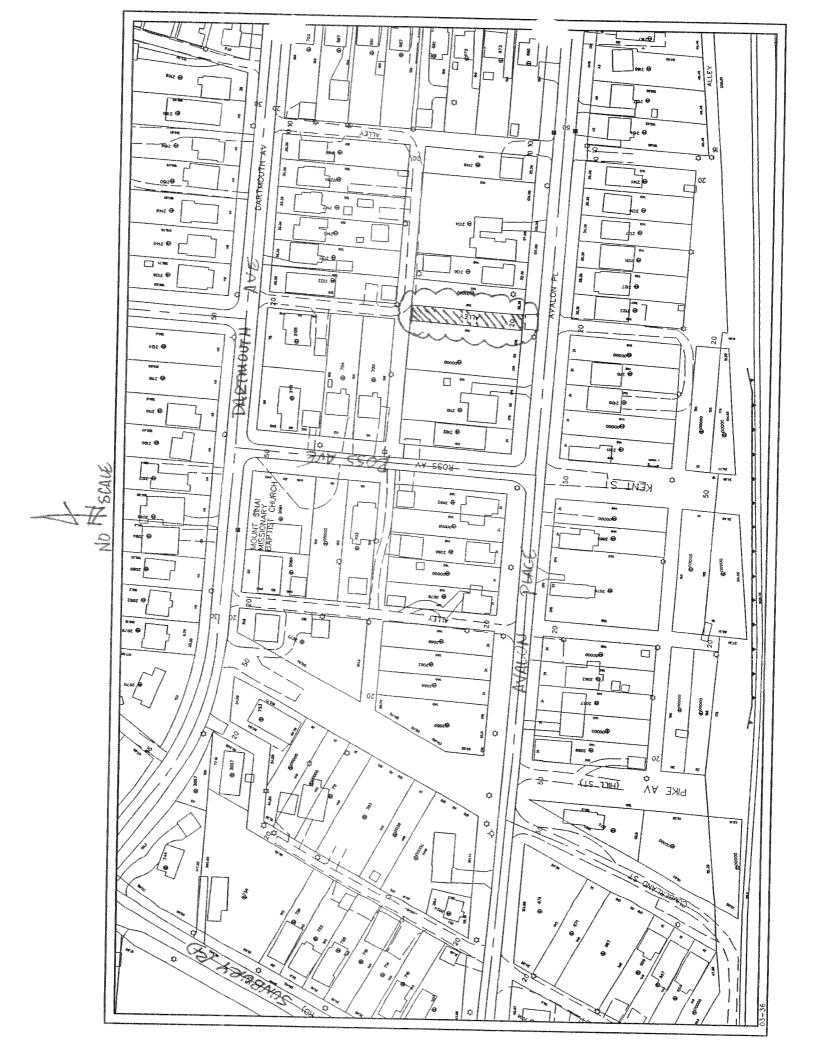
