

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING #2018-02

Regarding Appendix A

Pursuant to Section 32.3 of the Collective Bargaining Contract between the City of Columbus and the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, Ohio Council 8, Local 1632, the parties hereby agree to amend the Collective Bargaining Contract dated April 1, 2017 - March 31, 2020, by amending Appendix A of the Contract as follows:

The parties agree to increase the minimum and maximum pay for the following classification:

<u>Class Code</u>	<u>Class Title</u>	<u>Pay Range</u>
0445	Police Records Technician	From: 16 to 21 To: 17 to 24

Concurrent with the pay range adjustment, incumbent employees in the Police Records Technician classification who are employed as a Police Records Technician on the payday of the subsequent full pay period following City Council's acceptance of this MOU will advance one (1) pay range (i.e., incumbents in pay range 20 will move up to pay range 21) and retain their current step. Any such advancement in pay will not be retroactive.

An ordinance will be submitted to City Council requesting its acceptance of this MOU, and the effective date will be established by City Council's acceptance.


