I. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE – Job Creation

The Department of Development recommends a Jobs Growth Incentive of twenty-five percent (25%) for a period of five (5) years for the purpose of creating 50 new permanent full-time positions with an annual payroll of approximately \$3.88 million and the retention of 164 full-time employees.

II. PROJECT HISTORY

Highlights for Children was founded in 1946 by Dr. Garry Cleveland Myers and Caroline Clark Myers in Honesdale, Pennsylvania. The company is a family media brand of magazines and books dedicated to the belief that children are the world's most important people. Highlights for Children magazine offers kids an opportunity to discover a love for learning, while exploring new experiences in science, reading and puzzle solving. Sportsmanship, health, safety and good manners are frequent themes of the 40-plus-page magazine. Highlights for Children also operate other publishers, mostly located in Ohio, Pennsylvania and the New England area of the United States. The Highlights group focuses on everything from professional development seminars and conferences for educators to publishing children's books and producing magazines and professional books for teachers.

Highlights for Children is proposing to expand its corporate headquarters by making an investment of approximately \$1.0 million, including furniture and fixtures, retain 164 full-time jobs and create approximately 50 new full-time permanent positions with an estimated annual payroll of \$3.88 million.

Highlights for Children is requesting a 25%/5-year Jobs Growth Incentive from the City of Columbus to assist in the development of this project.

III. PROJECT INVESTMENT

IV. DECISION & TIMING

The project would begin in March 2013 with a scheduled time of completion for December 2013, contingent upon City Council approval of the recommended tax incentive.

V. EMPLOYMENT

The project will create 50 new full-time permanent positions with an estimated annual payroll of \$3.88 million and retain 164 full-time jobs with an annual payroll of approximately \$12.61 million.

VI. REQUESTED PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The Department of Development recommends a Jobs Growth Incentive equal to twentyfive percent (25%) of the amount of new employee city income tax withholding for five (5) years.

VII. WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Employers granted a tax incentive will meet with the Central Ohio Workforce Investment Corporation (COWIC) to develop a relationship to assure continuing employment opportunities for Columbus residents who are unemployed or underemployed.
