## **1997-2026**

Co-Founder and Partner at TRIAD Architects, LLC, Columbus, Ohio. Clyde led many design teams for the renovation of historic properties, new projects, and land planning. He led the design of the Greenfield Exempted Village School's campus. Greenfield is the only Ohio school to be listed in Archipedia, and featured in publications by the National Trust, American School & University, School Planning and Management, and Design Cost Data as a best practice in historic renovation. The project was also recognized by the National Trust and was presented with their Excellence In Design award.

## **1987-1997**

Partner at MCB Architects. Clyde led design teams, and managed employee development. In 1999, he was part of the statewide evaluation of all school facilities that led to the most significant state funding program in history. He also designed the restoration of numerous historic buildings, including The Brumback Library, the oldest county library in the United States.

## **1976-1987**

Founded and managed The Learning Tree, a comprehensive educational pre-school and latchkey program. The program was so innovative and well-respected that Governor Rhodes asked Clyde to serve on a state committee to evaluate Child Day Care in Ohio and to draft a legislative proposal to enact the State's Day Care Provider Law. This law has been in effect ever since, with only minor changes.

## **1973-1976**

Director of the Art Department for The Education Center of Bonao, Bonao, Dominican Republic. In addition to developing the K-12 curriculum for this 350-student private school, Clyde also worked on the accreditation team which resulted in the school becoming the world's first American-accredited bilingual school.

## **Public Service**

### **2002 – Present**

#### **Ohio Historic Site Preservation Advisory Board**

Clyde has served on the Ohio Historic Site Preservation Advisory Board since 2002. He served three terms as chairman and was recently reappointed in March of 2026. The board evaluates properties nominated to the National Register of Historic Places and recommends their inclusion on the register.

### **2015 – Present**

#### **Historic Resource Commission for the City of Columbus**

The Historic Resource Commission was established by Ordinance # 2638-80 in 1980. The Historic Resource Commission consists of nine (9) mayoral appointees. The Commission maintains the Columbus Register of Historic Properties and promotes the conservation of the city's historic sites and structures.

### **2007**

#### **Advantage Ohio Regulatory Reform Initiative**

Clyde served as chair for the evaluation committee of the Ohio School Facilities Commission, which changed state policy to permit the renovation of school facilities up to the cost of new and beyond with additional local funding. The evaluation of existing buildings was also adjusted to be more favorable to historically significant schools.

### **2006 – 2022**

#### **Ohio Writers' Guild**

Clyde has served on the Executive Board of the Ohio Writers' Guild since 2006. The guild is Ohio's oldest author organization. In addition to promoting Ohio writers, its members actively mentor new authors.

### **2020 – 2024**

#### **Columbus Landmarks Foundation**

Clyde served as board member of the foundation and continues as an active member. The work of the board is to identify, and advocate for the preservation of Columbus landmarks and to promote exemplary architecture in the city.
