



Dear Jeff:

Children's Hospital is planning a clinical expansion and renovation in its main hospital complex. Children's architects have determined that the best location for that project is at the intersection of Ann Street and Children's Drive in an area that will occupy a portion of the existing right of way of Children's Drive. This letter is to request that the City convey that portions of Children's Drive and Ann Street to Children's Hospital as part of the relocation of Children's Drive described below.

As part of the proposed project, Children's Hospital proposes that Children's Drive be relocated. The enclosed site plan shows both the existing and the proposed, relocated right of way lines. That site plan also shows the existing right of way which Children's wishes to acquire, the land which Children's will dedicate for the relocated right of way and the land which the City owns as part of an electric substation that will have to be dedicated as new right of way, if the relocation is to occur.

The proposed right of way lines for the relocated street shown on the site plan are not final, although Children's believes they are very close – close enough to begin this process. We expect to have this finalized with an engineered drawing in the next few weeks and will provide it to you as soon as it is available. In the meantime, we would very much like to move this process along as quickly as possible, with a goal of having this on the agenda for the April Land Review Commission meeting. That would enable us to have all of the necessary approvals and deeds in time for the scheduled June 16 start of the relocation.

In addition to dedicating land which Children's now owns for the relocated right of way, as shown on the enclosed site plan, Children's will perform and pay the costs of the

street relocation, which are estimated to be approximately \$437,000. Children's believes that the value of the land which it proposes to dedicate as right of way for the relocated street, plus the costs of the street improvements, will exceed the value of the right of way which Children's is requesting to have conveyed to it. Because of these mitigating factors, Children's requests that it not be required to pay any cash consideration to the City for the right of way to be conveyed to Children's

Children's Hospital owns all of the property on both sides of the right of way which it proposes to acquire, with the exception of the City's electric substation property. Representatives of Children's have spoken with both Director Doutt and Tony LaRe of the Division of Electricity concerning this. They have indicated the willingness of the Division of Electricity to participate in this relocation.

In order to meet the schedule for construction of the proposed project, it will be necessary for Children's to start the construction of the relocation of Children's Drive by June 16, 2003. Realizing the steps that we must go through before the relocation is approved and finalized, we would very much appreciate your assistance in starting and pursuing the process expeditiously. In that regard, it may be helpful for you to know that on December 12, 2002 a meeting was held to discuss the proposed relocation. The following City representatives were present at the meeting and indicated their approval for the relocation:
