REGARDING THE EXTENSION & MODIFICATION OF MOU #2022-05
THE CITY PARKS SPECIAL OPERATION 2022


The City of Columbus ("City") and the FOP agree to modify the Agreement between the City of Columbus and the Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge No. 9 (December 9, 2020 – December 8, 2023) by extending the provisions of MOU #2022-05, attached hereto, by three (3) weeks until September 26, 2022.

Whereas, the City and FOP agree to extend the terms of MOU #2022-05, as if fully stated herein, by three (3) weeks and amend paragraph #5 of MOU #2022-05 as follows:




