Work to be completed by this contract consists of the rehabilitation of approximately 79,040 LF of 8- thru 48-inch sewers utilizing the Cured-in-Place Pipe (CIPP) process, manhole rehabilitation, and other such work as may be necessary to complete the contract in accordance with the plans and specifications set forth in the Bid Submittal Documents.
