I write today to accept the offer of Roadwork Development (629) Grant and ODOT Grant assistance extended by the Ohio Development Services Agency and JobsOhio in a letter dated June 13, 2013 to the City of Columbus (City) in support of the proposed investment by Scientific Expert Analysis, Ltd. Your support for the project by way of these grants valued at a combined \$550,000 will prove invaluable to the project and will open up future development possibilities for the City.

Confirming your understanding of the project:


- The total estimated eligible roadwork costs for this project are \$1,224,797.
- Scientific Expert Analysis, Ltd. (S-E-A) will expand in the City of Columbus, Franklin County.
- Scientific Expert Analysis, Ltd. (S-E-A) will invest approximately \$8.1 million for its proposed project, including approximately \$8.0 million in building costs and approximately \$100,000 in machinery and equipment.
- Scientific Expert Analysis, Ltd. (S-E-A) will create approximately 30 new full-time jobs at the project location within the first three years of operation, and retain 96 existing full-time jobs.
- The created payroll for all new positions at the project location will be approximately \$3,055,550, excluding benefits.
- The baseline payroll for the previous twelve-month period was approximately \$9.77 million.
- Basic project information will become public once the project is approved by the State Controlling Board.

The City of Columbus will continue to work with members of your staff to ensure the appropriate authorities approve the awards. Thank you again for your support of this project, I look forward to forging a lasting partnership between our agencies as this proposal moves forward.
