The Department of Public Service solicited Requests for Proposals for the UIRF – General Traffic Engineering project. The recommendation is to award Michael Baker Jr., Inc., the consultant that was scored the highest by the selection committee. Details concerning the recommendation are below. The Department of Public Service solicited Requests for Proposals for the UIRF – General Traffic Engineering project. Funding for this project shall be provided by the Department of Development.

The Department of Public Service initiated a procurement effort that will result in the award and execution of a general traffic engineering contract. The intent of this contract is to provide the Department of Public Service with continuing, contractual access to additional resources that are necessary to perform various professional traffic engineering services as well as provide technical expertise for the department to produce studies and/or construction drawings for the Department of Development through the City's Urban Infrastructure Recovery Fund (UIRF) program.
