**Beginning** at a 1" iron pipe marking the northwest corner of said Lot 24, being 40.00 feet right of Hard Road centerline station 138+22.34;

Thence South 87 degrees 39 minutes 05 seconds East, a distance of 83.00 feet along the northerly line of said Lot 24, and along the existing southerly Right-of-Way line of Hard Road, to an iron pin set at the intersection with the proposed southerly Right-of-Way line of Hard Road, being 40.00 right of Hard Road centerline station 139+05.34;

Thence South 50 degrees 46 minutes 54 seconds East, a distance of 50.00 feet across said Lot 24, and along the proposed southerly Right-of-Way line of Hard Road, to an iron pin set at the intersection with the existing westerly Right-of-Way line of Foxboro Lane, being 70.00 right of Hard Road centerline station 139+45.34;

Thence South 02 degrees 20 minutes 55 seconds West, a distance of 55.00 feet along the existing westerly Right-of-Way line of Foxboro Lane, and along the easterly line of said Lot 24, to a 1" iron pin found marking the southwest corner of said Lot 24, being 125.00 feet right of Hard Road centerline station 139+45.34;
