This project consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, and labor necessary to install approximately 700 feet of 6” ductile iron water main and appurtenances line on South Washington Avenue from East Woodrow Avenue to Stanaford Place, and on Stanaford Place from South Washington Avenue to the first alley east of South 8th Street, and other such work as may be necessary to complete the contract in accordance with the plans and specifications.

6. **A narrative timeline for the contract including a beginning date, beginning and ending dates for known phases of the contract and a projected ending date.**

Work under this contract shall be completed within 45 calendar days after the NTP is issued.

7. **A narrative discussing the economic impact or economic advantages of the project; community outreach or input in the development of the project; and any environmental factors or advantages of the project.**

This project will replace an existing ninety year old galvanized 2” water line with a 6” water line. This will ensure the reliability of water service in a developing area. The Neighborhood Liaison(s) will be contacted and informed of this project during the construction phase. Further community outreach may result through the Neighborhood Liaison Program.
