I am in receipt of your letter dated November 6, 2014. I concur with your request to utilize the Court's Indigent Driver's Alcohol Treatment Fund (IDAT) under section 451 1.191(H) of the Ohio Revised Code.

It is my understanding that 5% of receipts is to be directed to the costs of assessments as completed by the Franklin County Municipal Court Assessment Specialist. Approximately \$220,000 will be used to obtain initial assessments, medical testing, the initial cost of the prescribed medication and on-going treatment services for certain opioid-addicted defendants. The remaining balance of approximately \$100,000 will be used for the assessment and treatment of defendants who are addicted to drugs other than opioids. All defendants will receive treatment in the ADAMH system of care with providers approved by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services.
