Funds for the project shall be reviewed and approved each year of the three year contract by City Council and the Mayor, and Auditor's certification of funds. Notwithstanding any provision in this Agreement to the contrary, the maximum obligation of the City for services described in this agreement for the period commencing on December 1, 2008 through December 31, 2009 ("Phase 1") is limited to the amount of four hundred thousand dollars (\$ 400,000), unless all the following occur: this Agreement is modified in writing; City Council enacts an ordinance approving the new amount; the Mayor has authorized the additional amount; and the Auditor has certified the additional funds. The City is not obligated to spend the maximum obligation authorized under this Agreement. Phase 2 costs under this agreement for the period from January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010 are estimated at three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00). Phase 3 costs for the period from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 are estimated at two-hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00).

An estimate of the full estimated cost of the Contract including a separate estimate of any and all phases or proposed future contract modifications.

Notwithstanding any provision in this Agreement to the contrary, the maximum obligation of the City for services described in this agreement for the period commencing on December 1, 2008 through December 31, 2009 ("Phase 1") is limited to the amount of four hundred thousand dollars (\$ 400,000), unless all the following occur: this Agreement is modified in writing; City Council enacts an ordinance approving the new amount; the Mayor has authorized the additional amount; and the Auditor has certified the additional funds.
