Specifically, that police should develop special units to establish contact with demonstrators to build trust and confidence. CDP collaborated with the Seattle Police Department who had already identified a world expert in crowd psychology and policing, whose research is driving the reforms in Europe, Professor Clifford Stott of Keele University in Staffordshire, England.
