Re: Clients with current contracts, pending contracts, future selection of contracts for Gannett Fleming, Inc. and TranSystems Corporation

To Whom It May Concern:

We greatly value our long-standing relationship and remain committed to seamless service and compliance with all contractual and regulatory requirements. We're writing to share updates on changes to our brand's two main operating entities, Gannett Fleming, Inc. and TranSystems Corporation, which will be coming together under one FEIN.

### What Changed

Gannett Fleming, Inc. has changed its name in its domicile state to GFT Infrastructure, Inc. effective May 30, 2025, and is in the process of updating its business and professional licenses to reflect the new name. This change:

- Does **not** affect the entity's corporate structure or FEIN.
- Does **not** impact other entities still using the "Gannett Fleming" name.
- Does **not** require a contract novation or assignment – only an amendment to reflect the name change. No other contract terms or conditions will be impacted, nor require modification.

As we amend our business registrations and professional licenses to reflect the new name in all of the jurisdictions we do business, we will provide you with any supporting documentation you require as evidence of the name change, and propose a simple amendment to update the entity name in existing contracts. Where changes are needed, pending any preferences you may have, we intend to expedite these changes by mid-July.

### What's Next

In mid-July 2025, employees of TranSystems Corporation will be transferred to GFT Infrastructure, Inc., so that all employees of those two companies will be employed by the same entity and under the same FEIN. We believe that transitioning existing TranSystems Corporation agreements to GFT Infrastructure, Inc., once our workforce is unified under a single FEIN, will streamline future staffing, improve operational flexibility, and allow us to assign the most qualified personnel to your projects.

We fully understand that some contracts may need to remain under their current legal entities, and we will continue to support those arrangements as needed. TranSystems Corporation will continue to exist to carry out contracts as necessary.

- Existing (pre-July) contracts under TranSystems Corporation (or its acquired subsidiaries) may be assigned—or, if preferred, novated—to GFT Infrastructure, Inc.
- Contracts awarded for procurements-in-process, if permitted, on or after mid-July will be entered into in the name of GFT Infrastructure, Inc.

## Other Changes Moving Forward:

- **Joint Venture Agreements:** For active or pending contracts held through joint ventures ("JV") in which either Gannett Fleming, Inc., or TranSystems Corporation is a venturer, we will first amend the internal JV agreements to reflect the name change or the employee transfer to GFT Infrastructure, Inc., as applicable. These updates will ensure consistency before we request corresponding amendments, assignments, or novations to the underlying contracts. We do not intend to change the names of most, if any, JVs; just update the JV agreements to reflect GFT Infrastructure, Inc.
- **Prequalification/registrations.** We will work to update, consolidate or, if appropriate, resubmit our prequalifications and/or registrations with you to accurately reflect our name change and unified workforce under one FEIN.
- **Proposals.** Following your receipt of this letter, proposals that would have previously been submitted by TranSystems Corporation, or TranSystems' previously acquired subsidiaries, may be submitted under GFT Infrastructure, Inc. to reflect the appropriate entity at the time of contract award. Our project team(s) may be reaching out to your staff to confirm your preferred approach for submission of proposals to be awarded after our FEIN consolidation.

Our goal is to complete contract transitions where needed **by Oct. 30, 2025.**

The information provided here applies to contracts held by Gannett Fleming, Inc., TranSystems Corporation and its acquired subsidiary entities. It does not apply to contracts held by entities that are required to be maintained separately from Gannett Fleming, Inc. or TranSystems Corporation for legal reasons, including to meet licensing requirements in various jurisdictions.

We have a team dedicated to making this process as simple for you as possible, and there is flexibility in our suggested approach. Please reach out to your GFT contact to identify any documentation you may need to implement these changes, or for more information on the changes.

Thank you for your patience throughout this exciting process. We look forward to continuing to serve you as GFT Infrastructure, Inc.
