In the second year, they will provide 75% of load requirements and in the third year will provide 50% of the load requirements.

The contract will begin January 1, 2007 and end December 31, 2009.

\$4,312,900 is being requested at this time to cover service from January 1, 2007 until passage of the 2007 budget. Upon passage of the budget, an additional \$50,000,000 will be requested for 2007 needs. In the second year of the contract, AEP will provide 75% of the load requirement estimated to cost \$37,500,000 and in the third year they will provide 50% of the load requirement estimated at \$25,000,000.
