Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus, Section 27, ½ Section 40, Township 5, Range 22, Refugee Lands, being a strip of land out of that 0.379-acre tract as described in a deed to The Columbus Baptist City Mission Society, of record in Deed Volume 1915, Page 129, being also part of Lot 6 of Edmiston Earhart's Subdivision of record in Complete Record 18, Page 337, Court of Common Pleas and also shown on Survey Plat Book 2, Page 14, all references to deeds herein being to the records of the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, said strip being on the LEFT side of Lockbourne Road (and north of S.R. 104) as delineated upon plans prepared for the City of Columbus and designated as 2746 DR. E, and being more particularly described as follows:

All references herein to station and offset are to the centerline of construction of Lockbourne Road.

Beginning **FOR REFERENCE** at Franklin County Geodetic Survey (FCGS) Monument Number 1462 at the intersection of the centerline of Lockbourne Road with the centerline of Marion Road (from the west) and located at station 41+88.82; thence North 03°54'25" East, along the centerline of Lockbourne Road, a distance of 3035.98 feet to a Mag Nail set at the southeasterly corner of said 0.379-acre tract and at the northeasterly corner of that Parcel Three as described in a deed to Darius A. Talebi, of record in Instrument No. 200108140187844 and located at station 72+24.82, the **TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING**:

Thence North 86°01'30" West, along the northerly line of said Parcel Three, a distance of 30.00 feet to an iron pin set in the existing westerly right-of-way line of Lockbourne Road located 30.00 feet LEFT of station 72+24.84;

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Thence North 03°54'25" East, through said 0.379-acre tract and along said right-of-way line, a distance of 100.15 feet to an iron pin set in the southerly line of that 0.557-acre tract as described in a deed to Vahid G. Hagee and Neda Nassirzadeh, of record in Instrument No. 200009130184858 located 30.00 feet LEFT of station 73+24.99;

Thence South 86°01'30" East, along said southerly line, a distance of 30.00 feet to a Mag Nail set in the centerline of Lockbourne Road located at station 73+24.72

Thence South 03°54'25" West, along said centerline, a distance of 99.90 feet to the **TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING**.

Containing 0.0689 acre of land, of which the present road occupies 0.0689 acre leaving a net take of 0.0000 acre.

Bearings herein are based on field observations of established monuments FCGS 1462 and FCGS 8818, from the Franklin County Engineers Office, resulting in a bearing of North 03°54'25" East, for the existing centerline of Lockbourne Road north of Marion Road.

Iron pins set consist of a 5/8" rebar, 30" long capped with a plastic cap stamped "CITY OF COLUMBUS RIGHT-OF-WAY MARKER".
