The Department of Public Service solicited Requests for Proposals for the Roadway Improvements - Multimodal Transportation Plan project. The recommendation is to award Nelson\Nygaard, the consultant that was scored the highest by the selection committee and that was recommended by the selection committee after oral interviews. The Department of Public Service is initiating a procurement effort that will result in the award and execution of a professional services contract related to the development of a comprehensive city-wide multimodal transportation master plan. The purpose of that comprehensive planning document, referred to as the Columbus Multimodal Transportation Plan (CMTP), is to clearly explain City transportation planning and design policy and standards and to establish multimodal priorities for roadways in the City of Columbus. The contract shall be funded from DPS' 2014 CIB.

The project was formally advertised on the Vendor Services web site from March 13, 2014, to April 15, 2014. The city received five (5) responses. All proposals were deemed responsive and were fully evaluated when the Evaluation Committee met on April 18, 2014. The responding firms were:

The three (3) highest-scoring offerors—Nelson\Nygaard, Stantec, and Parsons Brinckerhoff—were invited to participate in oral interviews with the Evaluation Committee on April 28, 2014.

Following those presentations, the Committee would like to submit Nelson\Nygaard for the Director's review and recommendation for the following reasons:

- 1. Their presentation of approach on considering access management in this effort was well-received.
- 2. The Committee also liked their discussion of the trade-offs of modes in the planning effort (i.e., the notion that not every mode can or should be accommodated on every street).
- 3. Their team seemed familiar with the planning efforts being conducted by COTA and DPU (e.g., Project Blueprint) because both items were mentioned during their presentation.
- 4. Nelson\Nygaard responded well to questioning about outreach to minorities and ESL populations.
- 5. They put forth the best presentation relative to community engagement and public involvement.
- 6. Their presentation and approach spoke to the need to effect culture change more so than the other presentations.
