Central Ohio Bio Energy COBE has an interconnection agreement (ORD # 1285-2010) pursuant to which the generating facility is a “Behind the Meter” generating unit that will sell excess electricity to the Division of Power.

The Purchase Power Agreement was effective October 16, 2012. At the time of execution of the agreement a price for electricity was not available for the year 2017. The pricing has recently become available and the Division of Power and COBE desire to modify Exhibit A of the Purchase Power Agreement to reflect the rate in the Electricity Price Schedule for the year 2017 of \$42.25 per MWH.

If the contract modification was not anticipated and explained in the original contract legislation a full explanation as to the reasons the work could not have been anticipated is required. The Power Purchase Agreement was drafted with the assistance of legal counsel. Its provisions include a 5-year term with prices specified for each year. The price structure is contingent upon certain power supply costs of the Division. At the time of execution, these costs were not known for 2017. In the future, as annual renewals of the term may occur, similar modifications will likely be needed.

The City is obligated to purchase the excess energy produced by the Central Ohio BioEnergy facility and this agreement will be reviewed annually.
