[Surveyor's description of the premises follows]

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus, located in Farm Lot 14 of Flavel Tuller's Survey of Quarter Township 1, Township 2 North, Range 19 West, United States Military Lands, as recorded in Plat Book 3, Page 60, and being a part of Lot 106 of the Summerwood Section No. 1 Subdivision as recorded in Plat Book 51, Page 33, as conveyed to Roy L. Sewell and Debra L. Sewell, by deed of record in Official Record 21742 A17, all records of the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Being a parcel of land located on the right side of the Plat of the Centerline of Right-of-Way of FRA-C.R. 61-1.10, as recorded in Plat Book ____, Page ____;

Beginning for Reference at a 1" iron pipe found marking the southwest corner of said Lot 106, being 135.00 feet right of Hard Road centerline station 152+12.48;

Thence North 02 degrees 21 minutes 18 seconds East, a distance of 75.00 feet along the westerly line of said Lot 106, and along the existing easterly Right-of-Way line of Summerwood Drive, to an iron pin set at the intersection with the proposed southerly Right-of-Way line of Hard Road, being 60.00 feet right of Hard Road centerline station 152+12.48, and being the **Point of True Beginning**;

Thence along the arc of a curve to the right for 31.42 feet along the northwesterly line of said Lot 106, and along the existing southerly Right-of-Way line of Hard Road, having a radius of 20.00 feet, a central angle of 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds, a chord bearing of North 47 degrees 21 minutes 18 seconds East, a chord distance of 28.28 feet to a point being 40.00 feet right of Hard Road centerline station 152+32.48;

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Thence South 87 degrees 38 minutes 42 seconds East, a distance of 25.00 feet along the northerly line of said Lot 106, and along the existing southerly Right-of-Way line of Hard Road, to an iron pin set at the intersection with the proposed southerly Right-of-Way line of Hard Road, being 40.00 feet right of Hard Road centerline station 152+57.48;

Thence South 68 degrees 23 minutes 33 seconds West, a distance of 49.24 feet across said Lot 106, and along the proposed southerly Right-of-Way line of Hard Road, to the **Point of True Beginning**, containing 0.008 acres, more or less;

Of the above described area, 0.008 acres is contained within the Franklin County Auditor's Parcel 610-171910.

The bearing of South 87 degrees 38 minutes 42 seconds East for the centerline of Hard Road is based upon the Ohio State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone, NAD 1983 (1986 Adjustment), as measured using G.P.S. methods through the Franklin County Engineer's stations FRANK 74, FRANK 174, FCGS 7772, FCGS 6651, FCGS 2232, and FRANK 2218 RESET.

This description was based upon an actual field survey of Hard Road by Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., in October and November of 2010, under the direction of Tim A. Baker, Registered Surveyor Number 7818.

Iron Pins Set are 3/4 inches in diameter by 30 inches long with a 2 inch aluminum cap placed on top bearing the name "ODOT R/W" and "STANTEC".
