The below described parcel laying on the left side of the centerline right of way for Sunbury Road (R/W varies) as shown in the Right of Way plans for FRA-270-(31.01)(33.64), and being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at an iron pin set at the southeast corner of Lot 1 of the Strawberry Patch in Plat Book 57 Page 25 conveyed to Louis F. Speert in Instrument 200605120091836 and being on the westerly existing right of way of relocated Watt Road as acquired by the State of Ohio in Deed Book 2919, Page 89 and being the grantor's northeast corner, said pin being 75.74 feet right of the centerline of Watt Road at station 22+44.01 and being the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING** for the parcel herein described:

- 1) **Thence, along the grantor's east line and the west line of said relocated Watt Road, South 23 degrees 56 minutes 17 seconds East, 234.39 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar found in good condition at the southeast corner of the said 5.892 acre tract and being the northwest corner of the intersection of said Relocated Watt Road and Sunbury Road, said pin being 50.00 feet left of the centerline of Sunbury Road at station 21+96.26;**

Rogers and Julie A. Moudry Co-Trustees of the Kristee M. Rogers and Julie A. Moudry Revocable Family Trust as recorded in Instrument 202312050126377, said pin being 50.00 feet left of the centerline of said Sunbury Road at station 21+70.42;
- 3) **Thence**, along the south line of said 5.892 acre tract and the north line of said 4.691 acre tract, **North 86 degrees 19 minutes 58 seconds West, 20.80 feet** to an iron pin set, said pin being 65.00 feet left of the centerline of said Sunbury Road at station 21+56.01;
