Original contract covered: engineering design services for asbestos abatement and heating system replacement, preparation of bid documents, bidding services, construction administration / construction inspection services. This modification will provide for additional design services related to the redesign of the back-up fuel source as propane instead of fuel oil and construction inspection services for this alternative back-up fuel installation. No future phases of this project are anticipated.

Contract completion for the construction is October 15, 2007. Engineering services will continue thru January 2008

This is the first proposed contract modification.

This contract modification will provide for engineering design for changes which were implemented after evaluating energy efficiency and environmental issues which prompted a re-design for the back-up fuel system from previously utilized fuel oil to proposed new propane gas system. These changes were not originally anticipated or included in the original project scope but were implemented after discussions with Water Treatment Plant staff and the design consultant.
