**CONTRACT FOR CRANE AND HOIST MAINTENANCE SERVICES
FEM PROJECT NO. 1402.2**

DIVISION OF SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE FACILITIES

1. Names, locations, and business status of all entities submitting Bids:

A. Brehob Corporation, 2476 Creekway Drive, Columbus OH 43207, a Majority enterprise. No other bids were received.

2. Scope of work to be performed: This is a contract for the annual inspection, certification, and needed maintenance of the approximately 112 cranes and hoists, and a number of hoisting appurtenances, all in use in the facilities of the Division of Sewerage and Drainage. This specialized work is needed to provide safety-rated operational and maintenance facilities. In addition to routine preventive and breakdown maintenance of this class of equipment, the contract as bid provides for the removal and replacement of two antiquated hoists, one at the Screen Building of the Jackson Pike Wastewater Treatment Plant, and the other in the Pump House Maintenance Shop at the Sewer Maintenance Operations Center.

3. Schedule to contract completion; "phasing": The contract is specified as a one-year commitment, with an option for the City to extend for two additional years if work is satisfactorily performed. Given annual funding from the O&M budget, the initial contract appropriation is proposed by Ordinance 00371-2007, with incremental funding by modification ordinance in each of the two years thereafter.

4. Estimated Costs over the full contract period: In addition to the first year cost bid, the Bidders were required to bid escalation costs for the other two potential years of the contract. These costs are as follows:
