BACKGROUND:

• The 0.37± acre site is zoned in the R-1, Residential District and is undeveloped. The applicant requests the L-R2-F, Limited Residential District to permit residential uses.

- To the north are single-family dwellings in the R-1, Residential District. To the south across Strimple Avenue is vacant land and attached single-family dwellings in the L-R-2F, Limited Residential District. To the east and west are single-family dwellings in the R-1, Residential District.
- The site lies within the boundaries of *The Northland Plan (2001)*, but is not specifically addressed.
- The limitation text includes lighting, building material commitments, landscaping and access provisions.

<u>CITY DEPARTMENTS RECOMMENDATION</u>: Approval. The proposed two-family dwellings are consistent with the zoning and development patterns of the area.
