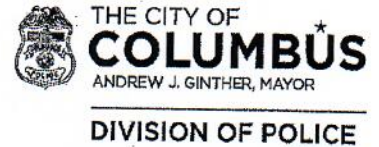

Sir,

The following investigation was conducted concerning the City of Columbus' 2017 annual objection to the renewal of liquor permit **2655587** issued to **FATHE FOOD INC**, which is doing business as **MOSES ONE STOP SHOP** located at **1609 Cleveland Ave. Columbus, Ohio 43211**. The recorded owner of said permit is **Ziyad M. Hamed**.

After reviewing the State of Ohio, Franklin County, and City of Columbus records regarding the above liquor permit establishment, the following information has been compiled to support the objection to the renewal of the aforementioned permit issued by the State of Ohio.

The above listed liquor establishment has been issued a **C-1**, and **C-2** permit by the Division of Liquor. This permit grants the permit holder the privilege to sell alcoholic beverages at the above listed address.

An inquiry of liquor violations revealed that the permit holder has received the following violations between **2016** and **2017**:

January 6, 2017



A review of the Columbus Division of Police records revealed the Division of Police have created **(35) thirty five** official police reports concerning incidents at the listed liquor establishment between **January 2016 and November 2017**. These reports referenced thefts, trespassing, wanted person arrests, liquor law violations, wanted persons, drug offenses, robbery, criminal damaging, motor vehicle theft, field interviews, on view arrests, and weapon offenses.

In addition, the Columbus Division of Police have been dispatched to **1609 Cleveland Ave. Columbus, Ohio 43211** on **(35) thirty five** calls for service at **Moses One Stop Shop**.

Furthermore, this establishment is currently boarded up due to a Nuisance Abatement ruling.
