# FACT SHEET EXEL FREIGHT CONNECT INC. & EXEL INC. JANUARY 2014

#### I. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE – JOB CREATION

The Department of Development recommends a Columbus Downtown Office Incentive with Exel Freight Connect Inc. and Exel Inc. for a tax incentive of fifty percent (50%) for a period of four (4) years with the option to increase the term by one (1) year upon Exel Inc. exercising its lease renewal option to extend the lease term by a minimum of one (1) year (resulting in a total lease term of seven (7) years) in consideration of the creation of 117 new full-time permanent positions with an associated annual payroll of approximately \$7.22 million.

#### II. PROJECT HISTORY

Incorporated in 1983, Exel Inc. has a long history of providing third party logistics services across the United States, including Central Ohio. In order to expand its transportation offerings for its customers, Exel Inc. created a transportation brokerage operation in North America – Exel Freight Connect Inc. Exel Freight Connect Inc. was incorporated in 2013 and is fully backed by Exel Inc. The brokerage operation will leverage Exel Inc.'s existing managed transportation operation, dedicated fleet routes, and its base of warehouse customers. The service offerings include freight brokering, fulfillment, and administration.

Exel Inc. is proposing to lease approximately 26,000 sq. ft. of office space located at 226 N. 5th Street, Suite 400 Columbus, Ohio 43215 to create a centralized brokerage operation near their corporate office in Central Ohio. Exel Inc. will accomplish an expansion of transportation service offerings as provided by Exel Freight Connect Inc., an affiliated company, which will occupy and equip the leased office space. The company will invest approximately \$524,000 related to the acquisition of furniture and fixtures, stand-alone computers, and improvements to the existing facility. The company will create 117 new full-time permanent positions with an associated annual payroll of approximately \$7.22 million to meet customer demands.

Exel Freight Connect Inc. and Exel Inc. are requesting a Columbus Downtown Office Incentive from the City of Columbus to assist in the establishment of operations in the downtown business district.

#### IV. DECISION & TIMING

The project will begin soon after Columbus City Council approval of the recommended tax incentive with a scheduled time of completion of April 2014.

# V. EMPLOYMENT

The project will create 117 new full-time permanent positions with an associated annual payroll of approximately \$7.22 million.

## VI. REQUESTED PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The Department of Development recommends a Columbus Downtown Office Incentive equal to fifty percent (50%) of the amount of new employee city income tax withholding for a term of up to four (4) years with the option to increase the term by one (1) year upon Exel Inc. exercising its lease renewal option to extend the lease term by a minimum of one (1) year.

# VII. WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Employers granted a tax incentive will meet with the Central Ohio Workforce Investment Corporation (COWIC) to develop a relationship to assure continuing employment opportunities for Columbus residents who are unemployed or underemployed.

#### IX. TAX BENEFIT

The recommended Columbus Downtown Office Incentive could yield cash payments totaling approximately \$361,000 for Exel Freight Connect Inc. and Exel Inc. over the incentive term of four (4) years with the possibility of receiving an additional cash payment of \$90,250 (total of \$451,250), should Exel Inc. exercise its lease renewal option to extend the lease term by a minimum of one (1) year, resulting in a total lease term of at least seven (7) years and a total incentive term of five (5) years.

### X. AREA IMPACT/GREEN INITIATIVES

Exel Inc. is part of the Supply Chain division of Deutsche Post DHL, the world's leading logistics group. Deutsche Post DHL was the first globally operating logistics company to set itself a concrete CO2 efficiency target.
