This contract provides for the installation of mechanical joint seals on approximately 215' of 48" concrete storm sewer pipe that runs through and along the left embankment section of O'Shaughnessy dam. This contract is being undertaken to assure the safety of O'Shaughnessy dam during extreme storm events and to meet requirements of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission who has regulatory jurisdiction over the dam.

A narrative timeline for the contract including a beginning date, beginning and ending dates for known phases of the contract and a projected ending date.

Emergency Legislation is being requested for this Contract to meet an FERC imposed deadline for this work of July 30, 2006. We anticipate issuing a Notice to Proceed in early June 2006. The Contract duration is 60 calendar days from notice to proceed. The actual field work should take only 2-3 days.

An estimate of the full estimated cost of the Contract including a separate estimate of any and all phases or proposed future contract modifications.

The low bid submitted for this work was \$35,351.00 of which \$4,611.00 is force account. No modifications of this contract are anticipated.
