To provide single lane closures on the median lanes in both directions at the same time on the freeway system within the City of Columbus to allow for City employees to replace lighting.

This modification is solely for the purpose of increasing the funding for the purchase of Traffic Control Services during the remainder of 2009 and until such time that additional funding is

Traffic Control Services are an essential service to the Division of Power and Water on an ongoing basis. When the current contract was established, it was set up with funding adequate for the first year of the contract. This modification will provide funding from the 2009 operating budget to continue services during the remainder of 2009 and until additional funding is available from the 2010 budget.

The City has contracted with Paul Peterson Company to provide traffic control services through September, 2010. This request is a planned modification necessary to increase funding needed for the continuation of services. There is no change in the scope of the contract.
