This contract provides Electric Motor Maintenance Services on an annual basis for the two (2) wastewater treatment plants within the Division of Sewerage and Drainage, the Jackson Pike Wastewater Treatment Plant and the Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant. The work includes such services as motor reconditioning, motor rewind, complete vibration analysis and motor overhaul for a variety of electric motors that controls various plant equipment.

The contract will continue to provide Electric Motor Maintenance Services for the Division of Sewerage and Drainage at the Jackson Pike and Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plants.

The Division is preparing the documents for a new advertisement and bidding documents for these services, but a new contract will not be in place before the existing contract expires. This modification is to provide an extension of the final year of the current contract to October 31, 2011.

Work under this modification is a continuation of services included in the scope of the original bid contract. No lower pricing/more attractive terms and conditions are anticipated at this time.
