This memorandum is a recommendation for construction contractor selection and processing the construction legislation for the Pedestrian Safety Improvements – Obetz Road Sidewalks project.

Project Scope:

The work consists of constructing 2,662 linear feet of sidewalk on Obetz Road between South High St. and Beth Ann Drive; replacing existing drives as indicated on the plans; removing and replacing existing pavement at Obetz and High St. intersection; and reconstructing curb ramps, miscellaneous drainage improvements, and other such work as may be necessary to complete the contract in accordance with the plans and specifications set forth in the Bid Submittal Documents.

Fiscal Impact: Source of funds are 2010 Bonds Fund (cash) and New Freedom Grant.

Planned funding amount is: \$218,000.00

Engineer's estimate, including inspection (25%), is: \$272,479.14 Low bid amount, including inspection (25%), is: \$275,732.73

Difference between planned funding amount and low bid amount is: \$57,732.73
