It has been determined that it will be beneficial to have the Columbus Downtown Development Corporation (CDDC), 150 South Front Street Suite 210, Columbus, Ohio 43215, perform the administration of this project.
City's best interest to make the necessary upgrades to the water lines and signal traffic interconnect lines in the entire RiverSouth area. The roadway work on Civic Center Drive administered by the CDDC already includes signal and utility work as part of a Recreation and Parks contract. It was determined by the Department of Public Utilities and the Department of Public Service that a need existed to add this work to the existing CDDC work because of their familiarity with the Scioto Mile project along Civic Center Drive and the ability to coordinate this project with other downtown projects including the Main and Rich Street Bridges and the River South projects.
This action would require that the formal competitive bidding process prescribed by Section 329 of the Columbus City Code, 1959, be waived.
