Attached please find a request to sell the second unimproved alley west of Northwest Boulevard from Ida Avenue to the alley north thereof. Asim Sheikh and Nelda Gentile, the abutting property owners, contacted the City and requested the City sell this unimproved right-of-way to them for \$6.50 per square foot for a total of \$12,870.00. Sale of this excess right-of-way will allow for side yard expansion of the abutting lots. After investigation, it was determined the \$12,870.00 is equal to the Franklin County Auditors per square foot assessed value of the adjacent lots.

It is now necessary for the Development Department to review the attached information and determine the validity of the request for mitigation. When your review is complete and the outstanding issues have been resolved, please complete the final portion of the form and place this item on the Land Review Commission agenda for their consideration.





Dear Mr. LeVally,

We are writing this letter to ask the City of Columbus to sell to us the alley which runs between our two properties. The property was never developed into an alley and the city has never maintained the property. All of the previous owners of our respective properties and we have always maintained the property, which includes at least two very large mature trees. It seems that everyone involved with this property, including the city assumed it was part of our two lots. We only very recently found out of the existence of the alley when we had a survey done.

We wish to purchase the alley at the fair market value. According to the Franklin County Auditor's website: The market land value of lot 10 (1354 Ida Ave.) is \$42,000. That lot is 44.74' x 143.89' or 6,437 ft.², or \$6.52/ft.². The market land value of the west side of lots 2,4,6 & 8 (1342 Ida Ave.) is \$38,300. That lot is 41.13' x 143.8' or 5,914 ft.², or \$6.48/ft.². The average of our two lots which border the alley is \$6.50/ ft.². That average seems to be a fair value for the alley in question. The alley is 13.76' x 143.89' or 1,980 ft.². Applying the average square footage value (of our bordering lots) to the alley gives us a market land value of \$12,870.

It seems Columbus has no use for this property and no desire to maintain it. We on the other hand would like to continue to take care of and improve the property. Nelda has thought, and the city let her believe, the property has been hers for thirty years. Asim would like to use a part of the property to develop more housing.

In conclusion we want to pay the City of Columbus \$12,870 for a piece of property that is of no use to the city. The city has never taken care of this land, never acted like responsible owners of it, but we have. We have acted like the owners, because we thought we were the owners. And now we want to make it official. In the process we will save the city money that would have to be used to maintain the land. Also we will make improvements and increase the tax revenue Columbus receives from us.
