Commencing for reference at the intersection of the existing west right-of-way line for said James Road and the existing south right-of-way line for Brownlee Avenue, both established by said East Minster Addition, being the northeast corner of said Lot 352, said point being 43.99 feet left of James Road proposed centerline of construction Station 110+29.08;

Thence South 04 degrees 26 minutes 27 seconds West, along the existing west right-of-way line for said James Road and along the east line of said Lot 352, a distance of 6.49 feet to an iron pin set on the proposed west right-of-way line for said James Road, said iron pin set being 43.99 feet left of James Road proposed centerline of construction Station 110+22.59, and said iron pin set being the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING for the herein described temporary easement;

Thence **South 04 degrees 26 minutes 27 seconds West**, continuing along the existing west right-of-way line for said James Road and continuing along the east line of said Lot 352, a distance of **50.26 feet** to the southeast corner of said Lot 352, being the northeast corner of Lot 351 of said East Minster Addition, as said Lot is described in a deed to Harold J. Kenneweg and Laverne R. Kenneweg, Trustees of the Kenneweg Family Trust, of record in Instrument Number 200304280122800, said point being 43.99 feet left of James Road proposed centerline of construction Station 109+72.33;

Thence North 85 degrees 33 minutes 34 seconds West, along the south line of said Lot 352 and along the north line of said Lot 351, a distance of 7.00 feet to a point, said point being 51.00 feet left of James Road proposed centerline of construction Station 109+72.33;

Thence across said Lot 352 along the following three (3) described courses:

1. North 04 degrees 26 minutes 27 seconds East, a distance of 44.25 feet to a point, said point being 50.99 feet left of James Road proposed centerline of construction Station 110+16.59;

- 2. North 22 degrees 56 minutes 31 seconds West, a distance of 14.08 feet to an iron pin set on the existing south right-of-way line for said Brownlee Avenue, being the north line of said Lot 352 and the proposed west right-of-way line for said James Road, said iron pin set being 57.46 feet left of James Road proposed centerline of construction Station 110+29.08;
- 3. South 59 degrees 50 minutes 34 seconds East, along the proposed west right-of-way line for said James Road, a distance of 14.96 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING for the herein described temporary easement.

The above described temporary easement contains a total area of **0.009 acres** located within Franklin County Auditor's parcel number 010-090575.

The bearings described herein are based on Grid North (reference South 85 degrees 47 minutes 50 seconds East for Livingston Avenue east of James Road) as referenced to the Ohio State Plane Coordinate System (South Zone) and the North American Datum of 1983 (CORS '96). As established utilizing a GPS survey referencing ODOT CORS stations "COLB", "OHLI" and "OHMD".

Iron pins set are 30" by 5/8" diameter rebar with caps stamped "American Structurepoint PS 8438".
