SUBJECT: Ranking of Offerors for RFQ025678, Cherwell to Ivanti Neurons

The evaluation committee for RFQ025678 submits this ranking of offerors, including the explanation of the basis for the ranking, to Sam Orth III, Director and CIO, Department of Technology (DoT) for consideration and for inclusion with the associated contract file.

Pursuant to CCO 329.27, DoT, through utilization of requests for statements of qualifications, received three (3) responsive statements of qualifications in response to RFQ025678 for Cherwell to Ivanti Neurons licensing and professional services. A nine (9) member evaluation committee representing the Department of Technology evaluated statements of qualifications, 7 of which scored statements and 2 of which observed and provided input.

- Reviews included offerors' workbooks and 40+ supporting documents with over 120 pages.
- Evaluators used these materials to score vendors on all submission requirements.

In accordance with subsection (g), the committee ranked the proposals based on the quality and feasibility of each proposal, taking specific consideration of the offeror qualifications, the comprehensive nature of the information provided as it related to satisfying mandatory requirements, competency in project delivery of upgrading from Cherwell to Ivanti Neurons and total value provided for cost. On this basis, the committee ranked all offerors as follows: (1) T4S; (2) Avante; (3) Carahsoft.

These scores are an aggregate of the Evaluation committee individual scores out of 100 possible points.
