# **Site Information**

- The 7.67 acre site is an infill annexation.
- The current use is apartments and office-warehouse. The anticipated use is apartments.
- The site is not located in an Area Commission and is located within the boundaries of the Olentangy West Area Plan, which recommends High Density Residential and Employment Center for the site.
- The site does not require a boundary conformance.

# **Key Issues**

- Annexation is sought to obtain city services to facilitate redevelopment for residential use.
- Planning staff have conducted a preliminary review and are supportive of the proposed use. It is consistent with the plan recommendation.
- Annexation does not guarantee a zoning application will be approved. Zoning requests require a separate application process through the Department of Building and Zoning Services.

### **Legislative Information**

- The applicant must provide a statement of municipal services to the county for their consideration within 20 days.
- The annexation is tentatively scheduled for consideration at a Franklin County Commissioners hearing.
- The Ohio Revised Code stipulates that once an annexation has been approved by the county, it must be accepted
  by the receiving municipality in order for the annexation process to be completed. The acceptance process involves
  a second city ordinance that may be acted upon a minimum of 60 days from the date the City Clerk receives record
  of the commissioner's action and a maximum of 120 days of City Council's first consideration of the second city
  ordinance.
