This legislation authorizes the Department of Public Utilities, Division of Sewerage and Drainage, to upgrade the heating, ventilation, and air-conditioning (HVAC) control system at the Fairwood Avenue Facility. The HVAC control system's purpose is to maintain good air quality through adequate ventilation with filtration and to provide thermal comfort. The existing HVAC control system has become obsolete requiring an upgrade of the current Invensys System with new architecture, software upgrades, and new control equipment.
