Attached please find a request to sell portions of Kennedy Drive, Children's Drive West, Children's Drive and Ann Street to The Children's Hospital. Sale of this right-of-way will accommodate continued development of the Children's Hospital campus. The City Attorney's Real Estate Division has established a value of \$473,340.00 for these rightsof-way as indicated on the attached form. Current Land Review Commission policy requires that the City obtain an independent fee appraisal when the estimated value of the rights-of-way is greater than \$75,000.00, however, it is my understanding Children's Hospital has chosen to request the Land Review Commission waive this requirement. It is also my understanding Daniel H. Schoedinger, counsel for Children's Hospital, has submitted a request for mitigation of the \$473,340.00 to your office.

It is now necessary for the Department of Development to review the information provided and determine the validity of the request for mitigation. When your review is complete and any outstanding issues have been resolved, please complete the final portion of the attached Request for Conveyance form and place this item on the Land Review Commission agenda for their consideration.

Dear Mr. Schoedinger:

The City of Columbus, Transportation Division, has reviewed the request you submitted on behalf of your client, Children's Hospital, regarding their acquisition of portions of Ann Street, Children's Drive, Children's Drive West and Kennedy Drive. It is the Transportation Division's understanding acquisition of these rights-of-way will allow for continued development of the Children's Hospital campus. After investigation by the Transportation Division staff it was determined there are no objections to the proposed sale of these rights-of-way subject to the retention of general utility easements for any utilities currently located therein. Pursuant to Columbus City Council Resolution Number 113X-86, which provides for the sale of City owned property, and based upon information provided by the Franklin County Auditor, the City has estimated a total value of \$473,340.00 for these rights-of-way. (\$2.28 per sq. ft. X 52,500 sq. ft. = \$119,700.00 for those rights-of-way located west of Parsons Avenue and \$2.80 per sq. ft. X 126,300 sa. ft. = \$353.640.00 for those rights-of-way located east of Parsons Avenue). Current Land Review Commission policy requires that the City obtain an independent fee appraisal when the estimated value of the rights-of-way is greater than \$75,000.00, however, it is my understanding your client has chosen to request the Land Review Commission waive this requirement.

If your client desires to proceed with the acquisition of the above referenced rights-of-way please have this "Authorization to Proceed" letter signed and dated in the space provided below then returned, within thirty days, to Ms. Patricia A. Austin, P.E., Administrator, Transportation Division, Public Service Department, 109 North Front Street, 3rd Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215, Attention: Mary Lu English.

If your client objects to the estimated value of \$473,340.00 you will need to contact Ms. Donna Hunter, Administrator of the Land Management Office, to discuss a possible reduction of this amount. Ms. Hunter's address is: Development Department, 109 North Front Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. For your convenience I have attached a list of valid mitigating circumstances that the City will consider when reducing right-of-way transfer prices. Please include a copy of any correspondence you send to Ms. Hunter when you return this "authorization to proceed" letter. Unless mitigating circumstances that directly benefit the Transportation Division can be identified, our Division policy requires that a recommendation to transfer at full price be forwarded from this Division to the Development Department.


