The Department of Public Service solicited Requests for Proposals for the Intersection Improvements – Gender Road at Refugee Road project. The contract shall be funded by ODOT (90%) and the Department of Public Service (10%, cash).

The intent of this project is to provide the City of Columbus, Department of Public Service with completion of the Project Development Process (PDP) for improvements to the intersection of Gender Road at Refugee Road.
