

## 2025 Ohio Buckles Buckeyes Site Stipend Application

This project is to provide support for up to eight Occupant Protection Regional Coordinators (OPRC) to provide funding to their regional low-income car seat programs, the Ohio Buckles Buckeye (OBB) program. This funding will help with cost associated with the administration of the OBB's programs, which can include personnel costs, resources (i.e. car seats, educational materials), travel for car seat events for the OBB program (following state of Ohio mileage rate), continuing education/conference registration for child passenger safety (CPS) in Ohio).

Funding shall total no more than eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$88,000) with each OPRC receiving up to \$1,000 per county in their region. If a county has a vacancy, the OPRC may apply for funding for that county, but must demonstrate with submitted documentation how those funds were utilized within that county.

Occupant Protection Regional Coordinators (OPRC's) interested in pursuing this funding for the OBB sites within their region shall consider the Application Pre-requisites and provide the requested information to apply for these funds. Determinations on Applications shall be made in ODH's sole discretion.

### **Application Pre-requisites**

- a. Applicant must be currently funded by ODH as the OPRC for their region.
- b. Applications shall serve as funding agreements between the parties, ODH and the OPRC's.
- c. Applications shall be signed and emailed to Gregory.Schneider@odh.ohio.gov by 1/30/2025.
- d. Applicants must submit a letter of agreement with this application, on agency letterhead, indicating they will provide a stiped for each OBB site that completes the following quarter 1-3.
  - OBB Data Report on time.
  - Maintains regular contact with OPRC.
  - Distributes car seats and education on a regular basis for the OBB program.
  - Has a Child Passenger Safety Technician (CPST) on staff at the agency or partnership with nearby CPST within the county at the beginning and end of grant year.
- e. By June 30, 2025, the applicants will submit a "Summary of Stipend" for each OBB site who received funding by due date established by ODH.
- f. It will be the applicant's responsibility to ensure the OBB Program is spending the money as established in this agreement (personnel costs, resources (i.e. car seats, educational materials, travel for car seat events for the OBB program (following state of Ohio mileage rate), continuing education/conference registration for CPS in Ohio.
- g. Questions regarding this funding opportunity shall be forwarded to <a href="mailto:Gregory.Schneider@odh.ohio.gov">Gregory.Schneider@odh.ohio.gov</a>.
- h. OPRC's can only receive a maximum of one award per county within their region, unless an agency covers multiple OBB programs. That agency will receive up to \$1,000 per county covered in established agreements.
- i. Funds can be paid to the applicants in one-time payment.

<u>Unresolved Finding for Recovery and Debarment.</u> Applicant warrants that it is not debarred from consideration for contract awards by any governmental agency and it is not subject to an unresolved finding for recovery pursuant to Section 9.24 of the Ohio Revised Code. Applicant agrees that if this representation is deemed to be false, this Application shall be void *ab initio* and the Applicant shall immediately repay any funds paid under this Application, or an action for *recovery* may be immediately commenced by ODH for recovery of said funds.

<u>Liability Requirements.</u> Each party agrees, to the extent permissible by law, to be responsible for any liability, suits, losses, judgements, damages, or other demands brought as a result of their own respective negligent actions or omissions in the performance of this Application.

Non-Appropriation and OBM Certification. Notwithstanding any other terms of this Application, ODH's funds are contingent upon the availability of lawful appropriations by the Ohio General Assembly and/or other contract funding source. If the General Assembly or other contract funding source fails at any time to continue funding for the payments or any other obligations due by ODH under this Application, ODH will be released from its obligations on the date funding expires. Any obligations of ODH are subject to Section 126.07 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Entirety of Agreement.** All terms and conditions of this Application are embodied herein. No other terms and conditions will be considered a part of this Application unless expressly agreed upon in writing and signed by both parties.
